**Subject : Guidelines for Utilization of Untied Funds at Sub-Centres.**

Sir,  
In reference to the subject cited above I am to inform you that under NRHM / RCH-II, a concerted initiative is being taken by the Government to enable quality health services accessible for all in the rural areas of the State.

2. The provision of Untied Fund at Sub-Centres is one such step that is being taken to empower the Sub-Centres with minimum basic facilities so that rural populations have access to quality services at nearest Public Health Institution. It is in this endeavour that Guidelines for Utilization of Untied Funds at Sub-Centres is formulated to materialize this initiative and enclosed. The list is not exhaustive but indicative.

3. It may also be mentioned here that the Untied Funds are operationalised by virtue of joint accounts of PRI functionaries & ANMs/MPW(M). Therefore involvement of community in health planning & decision-making is involved which in turn provides an impetus to develop mechanism in meeting the unmet needs. The approval of the Sub-Centre Committee is mandatory for any such expenditure.

4. In view of the above you are requested that communication may be made at the earliest to the respective Sub-Divisional Medical Officers, concerned MOs at PHCs & all other concerned. The CDPOs are also a valuable stakeholder in this initiative for making effective communication inforging inclusion of concerned Anganwadi Centres in health development initiatives.
