Term & Conditions:-

- A) Job specifications/ responsibilities
- Instruct and demonstrate to the patients the proper methodology of bringing out sputum. Prepare slides from the thickest portion of sputum, read and record results. Maintain the Laboratory Register and report the results to the Medical Officer managing the patient.
 - Coordinate with other staff to ensure that patients with productive cough for two weeks or more undergo sputum examination and receive containers and necessary instructions.
 - Promote AFB microscopy as primary tool for diagnosis of TB. Ensure referral of >2-3 % of adult OPD patients.
 - Dispose of contaminated materials as detailed in the Laboratory Manual.
 - Assist STLS in implementation of EQA.
 - Collection and transportation of sputum specimens for culture and DST as per guidelines.
 - Any other job assigned as per programmed need.
