Memorandum

The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Govt. of India has launched **Swachha Bharat Abhiyaan(SBA)** on 2nd October 2014 which focuses on promoting cleanliness in public spaces. Health institution is major part of this initiative. Clean & infection free hospital & health centre is very essential for preventive and curative care. Under Nation Health Mission (NHM) several initiative has been taken up like; Bio-medical waste management, **Kayakalp Award, National Quality Assurance Standard(NQAS)** etc for improvement of quality services in public health institution.

To accelerate quality improvement initiative in each public health facility up to sub-centre level, following officer has been nominated as **District Nodal Officer of Quality Assurance** (as identified by district).

The above mentioned District Nodal Officer would function under supervision of Chief Medical Officer of concern district with close coordination with district level assessor. The major responsibility is to focus on quality improvement of public health facility to make clean and infection free hospital.

Scope of work for District Nodal Officer is:

1. Ensure roll out of standard protocols for RMNCH-A services (as well as for Disease Control Programme implementation).
2. Develop a plan for the Quality Assurance at each level of health institution in a phased manner.
3. Mentor the facility in-charges for implementing quality improvement measures at the facilities.
4. Compile and collate monthly data received from facilities on **Key Performance Indicator. (KPI)&** Send the regular reports to state.
5. Disseminate improvement with DQAC members and organize DQAC meeting.
Send the regular reports to state level.

This matter is important and takes necessary action on priority basis.


