

## MEMORANDUM

Pregnancy Induced Hypertension (PIH) and Hypertension has been identified to be the leading causes of maternal mortality and morbidity amongst the pregnant women. During the last meeting of the State level Task Force Committee of Maternal Death held on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2014 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, H&FW, Govt. of Tripura, it has been decided that henceforth and until further orders all MPWs and ANMs shall ensure screening of each pregnant women for **PIH** and **Hypertension** by measuring **Blood Pressure** and examination of **Urine** for **Albumin** to avoid maternal deaths.

2. **Medical Officers, (AYUSH) attached at PHCs, therefore, shall have ~~been~~ to maintain database of all PIH cases and its follow-up in detail at their respective PHC, any dropout of treatment of PIH is to be identified and treatment shall be provided.**


