



**MEMORANDUM**

As a continuing activity, School Health Programme (SHP) is to be implemented in all Government and Government Aided Schools of the State by conducting health check-up of school children (Classes I to XII) enrolled at Govt. & Govt. Aided to address 3Ds i.e. Deficiency, Disease and Disability through screening, treatment and referral. For further effective implementation of the programme effectively, it has been decided to entrust Doctors of **Ayurvedic/AYUSH** system under the Health Department for inspection of Schools and record the identified diseases in the Health Card at least two times in a year.

2. Existing School Health Cards which are already available at schools are to be utilized for the purpose till new School Health Cards is printed and provided by NRHM.


