**SHORT NOTICE INVITING QUOTATION (SNIQ)**

Tenders in a single sealed cover are hereby invited on behalf of the State Health and Family Welfare Society, Agartala from resourceful Manufacturer / Supplier / Distributor / Stockiest for procurement of 75,000 nos of Tablet Primaquine (2.5 mg) for the NVBDCP Programme under National Health Mission, Tripura as per specification and quantity given below:-


**Terms and conditions:**

1. Quotation will be received in a single sealed cover containing both technical & financial bid addressed to the Mission Director, National Health Mission, SIHFW Building, Palace compound, Agartala, up to **5:00 PM on 01/03/2021** by the concerned bidder through speed post/Registered post/Courier Services/ by hand.

Quotations are likely to be opened on **02/03/2021 at 11:30 AM**, if possible, in the Office of the undersigned. Name & address with phone no: of the tenderer and Reference number of the Short Notice Inviting Quotation should be mentioned clearly on the envelopes.

2. Tenders received after stipulated date and time will summarily be rejected.
3. Following documents are required to be submitted:-
  - a) Demand Draft as EMD amounting Rs. 5000/- (Five thousand only) (Refundable) from any schedule Bank, In favour of **M/s State Health & Family Welfare Society (NVBDCP), Agartala, Tripura** payable at Agartala. Tender EMD will be exempted as per Govt. norms (DFPRT-2019) but relevant documents need to be produced.
  - b) PAN Card
  - c) Copies of Valid Trade License and Drug License with renewal certificate thereof in respect of authorized dealer/distributor/stockiest.
  - d) Manufacturing license of the manufacturer.
  - e) Up to date C-GMP Certificate of the Manufacturer.
  - f) Authorization letter from manufacturer in cases of bid submitted by the dealer/distributor/stockiest.
4. If bid is submitted without any documents mentioned above, the bid will be rejected.

5. L1 bidder(s) will be selected among the technically qualified bidders.
6. Rates should be quoted both in word and figure. Overwriting or incomplete quotation will not be accepted.
7. Accepted rate will remain valid for one (01) year from the date of acceptance. SH&FWS may extend the accepted rate for another one year subject to satisfactory performance of the bidder.
8. The EMD money will be treated as security money for the bidder(s) to whom work order will be issued. For other bidder (s) EMD will be released after finalization of the tender.
9. Payments of bill will be made after completion of supply and scrutiny of In-House/NABL Test reports by competent authority. Admissible taxes will be deducted from the bill as per Govt. norms.
10. In case of legal dispute the jurisdiction will be the Tripura High Court, Agartala
11. The Mission Director(NHM), Government of Tripura, Agartala reserves the right to unilaterally terminate the contract or cancel the acceptance of the rate and firm at any time without notice before expiry of the period for which rates are now invited.
12. The Mission Director (NHM), Government of Tripura, Agartala also reserves the right to accept or reject Tender without assigning any reason thereof and Tender may be accepted or rejected in part or in whole.
13. Supply should be completed within 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue of supply order. A penalty @ 1% on the total value shall be charged for every week or part of week of delay beyond stipulated date of supply for a maximum period of 03 (three) weeks after which order shall be deemed to be expired. However, Relaxation will be entertained only in special circumstances (Natural Calamities, War or any other situation beyond human control).
14. Packaging and Shelf Life should be as per Schedule P1 and Schedule P respectively of Drugs & Cosmetics Act 1948.
15. At the time of delivery, In-House and NABL Test reports have to be submitted. Without these two reports the item will not be received.
16. If any batch of drugs supplied is found to be not of standard quality after testing at the time of receipt or during shelf life period of the drug, the entire stock should be taken back and replaced by fresh stock at the own cost of supplier / tenderer from the respective institutions.
17. In case of any breach of contract the EMD money will be forfeited.
